National Kaohsiung University of Hospitality and Tourism Bursary Guidelines for Financially Disadvantaged Overseas Chinese Students

Amended and adopted by internal signing memorandum on August 20, 2012

Article 1

This Bursary Guidelines for Financially Disadvantaged Overseas Chinese Students (the "Guidelines") of the National Kaohsiung University of Hospitality and Tourism (the "University") is hereby enacted pursuant to Point 6, Subparagraph 1 of the Bursary Rules of Ministry of Education for Financially Disadvantaged Overseas Chinese Students of Senior High Schools and Higher Education.

Article 2

Purpose:

The Guidelines is enacted to assist overseas Chinese students who are financially disadvantaged but diligent in study to finish school on schedule.

Article 3

Qualifications

- 1. The applicants shall fit under the definition of "financially disadvantaged overseas Chinese students" set forth in the Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan (excluding graduate students and students in extended study period).
- 2. Applicants in their second year or later shall have achieved a sufficient GPA for the previous school year and an average conduct score of 80 or above without being given any warning or more serious sanction by the University.
- 3. Students who have received subsidies for or exemption of tuition and incidental fees or financial aids from any government agency shall not apply for a bursary pursuant hereto.

Article 4

Rules

1. Quotas:

(1) The quotas allocated for each school is determined by the Ministry of Education based on the number of overseas Chinese students currently enrolled at such school.

- (2) A quota in proportion to the ratio of the number of first-year overseas Chinese students to the total number of overseas Chinese students will be allocated to the first-year overseas Chinese student applicants. The rest of the quotas will be allocated to the overseas Chinese student applicants of second-year or above.
- 2. Bursary Amount: The amount of bursaries will be granted and announced publicly by the Ministry of Education based on the budget of the fiscal year. The bursaries will be given for a period of one year, from the commencement of the first semester (September) to August 31 of the following year. Graduates will receive the bursaries till the month of graduation.
- 3. Bursary payments to students who are suspended or withdraw from school after the applications for the bursaries are granted will cease in the month following such suspension or withdrawal. Bursary payments to students who are given a demerit or subjected to expulsion from school by the Student Reward and Disciplinary Commission will cease in the month following the public announcement of such sanction made by the University.
- 4. Students who commit in the act of forgery or provide false documentations shall not only be disqualified for any future bursary payments but also return all bursary payments so far received. In addition, such students shall take any and all legal responsibility.

Article 5 Applications

- 1. After the first semester of each school year begins, qualified overseas Chinese students shall submit an application form (Schedule 1), proof of low income status, and all transcripts already obtained (except for first year overseas Chinese students) to the International Affairs Office to apply for bursaries.
- 2. Transferred overseas Chinese students shall additionally submit a proof of transfer and all transcripts already obtained.

Article 6 Review

1. The applications pursuant hereto shall be assessed and reviewed by the Bursary Review Team for Financially Disadvantaged Overseas Chinese Students (the "Review Team"), the members of which are served by the Dean of International Office, all Section Chiefs of the International Affairs Office and overseas Chinese student representatives. The assessment and review will be based on the information on the Bursary Eligibility Evaluation Form (Schedule 2). The review work for the applications of the current school year shall be completed by October 31 each year. The relevant review records shall be preserved by the University for future reference.

2. Standards:

- (1) For first-year student applicants, those with the highest subtotal of financial disadvantage points shall be first considered for the bursary payments; while for second-year or above student applicants, the highest total financial disadvantage points. In case of a tie, the order of bursary recipients shall be based on the order of the evaluation items set forth in the Bursary Eligibility Evaluation Form.
- (2) The living conditions of the applicants in Taiwan.
- 3. If deemed necessary, the University will request the Overseas Community Affairs Council to verify the information provided by the applicants on family condition and low income status.
- 4. A roster of the final recipients approved by the University in order of year of study will be prepared for submission to the Ministry of Education each year for approval.

Article 7

Matters in relation to funding applications, appropriations, reimbursements, and account reports shall be subject to the Ministry of Education's Operating Procedure Guidelines for Appropriations and Account Reports for Funds and Commissioned Work.

Article 8

The Guidelines shall come into effect upon approval by the President. Subsequent amendments shall be subject to the same approval procedure.
