Abstract

responsible tourism for sustainable transformation and inclusive societies. My main goals for

attending included boosting the global visibility of National Kaohsiung University of

Hospitality and Tourism (NKUHT), recruiting potential students, establishing international

connections, advancing responsible tourism education, and contributing to the research domain

through the presentation of my extended abstract, "Tourists' green purchase behavior The Role

of Green marketing, Environmental attitude, Environmental knowledge, and Green trust".

The event incorporated expert talks, collaborative panel discussions, practical field excursions,

and educational workshops. Through these activities, I gained valuable insights into global

trends in responsible tourism and sustainable approaches. The conference also provided

opportunities for forging networks and showcasing NKUHT's academic offerings to a broad

spectrum of academics, learners, and industry experts. Notably, my contributions were

recognized with the Best Paper Award for the paper co-authored with Dr. Chen and Janelle

Ebron, and I also received the Best Presenter Award individually. Based on this experience,

the report proposes future actions to amplify our institution's participation in upcoming events,

broaden faculty and student engagement, and continuously cultivate international alliances to

strengthen NKUHT's leadership in responsible tourism education.

1. Purpose
